- When and whether you are relocating or just rearranging the table(s), this must be done always by 2 persons. The table must be lifted by 2 persons not just hold it from the HPL top but holding it from the metal cross that is under the top. Do not drag it.
  If otherwise, there is danger the screws holding the top to get loosened and the top to be detached from the base/metal cross (and thus to brake) because the base is very heavy. If you will move it a long distance then it is suggested to be positioned on a trolley and to move it accordingly.
- Avoid mopping the table bases with detergents. Cleaning just with a dump cloth with just water.
- Use coaster under very hot pots or glass or other vessels, which contain ice cubes.
- **Routine cleaning.** High-pressure laminates can usually be wiped clean with just a damp cloth or sponge using a mild soap, non-bleach detergent, or a general-purpose cleaner. Ammoniated and/or vinegar-based glass cleaners are best for cleaning surfaces soiled by grease. Abrasive cleaners/powders and metal or abrasive-coated scouring pads should not be used on most laminates as they may permanently dull and scratch the laminate and make it more susceptible to staining.
