

Teak wood maintenance instruction

Teak is an oily wood that will turn grey when exposed to the elements. Some people prefer the grey, weathered look. Many do not.

To protect teak surfaces against UV radiation and adverse weather conditions we recommend, the use (once a year or when necessary) of

- <u>Option 1</u>: a water-based impregnation wood varnish (advantages: fast drying, breathable, water resistant, easy application, Non-cracking, non-peeling) or
- <u>Option 2</u>: <u>a boat varnish</u>, which- is much more hardwearing than oil, or water-based varnishes.

It is important that before applying the varnish to carefully sand using fine grit paper (240) and dust the surface. Equally important is the use of a quality brush.
